You can enter the Festival from either end of Exhibition Road.



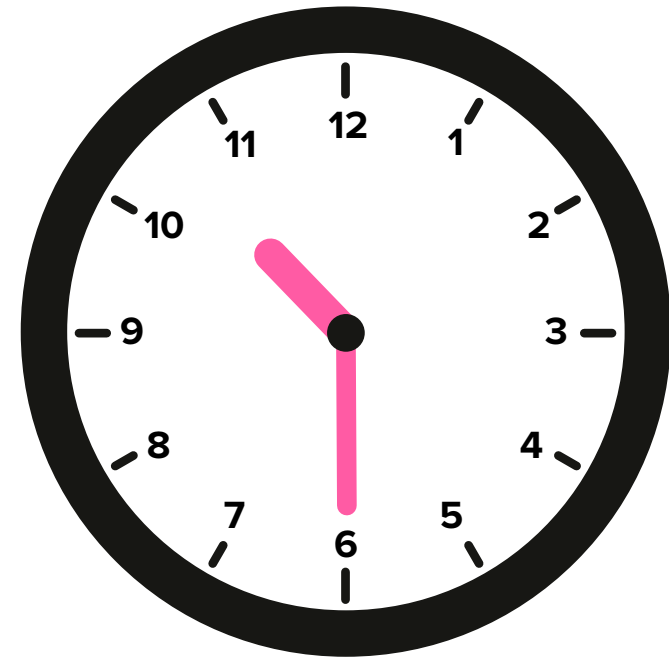

There are two **information points**. You can find them on Exhibition Road and Imperial College Road. Here, staff can help you plan your visit and answer questions.

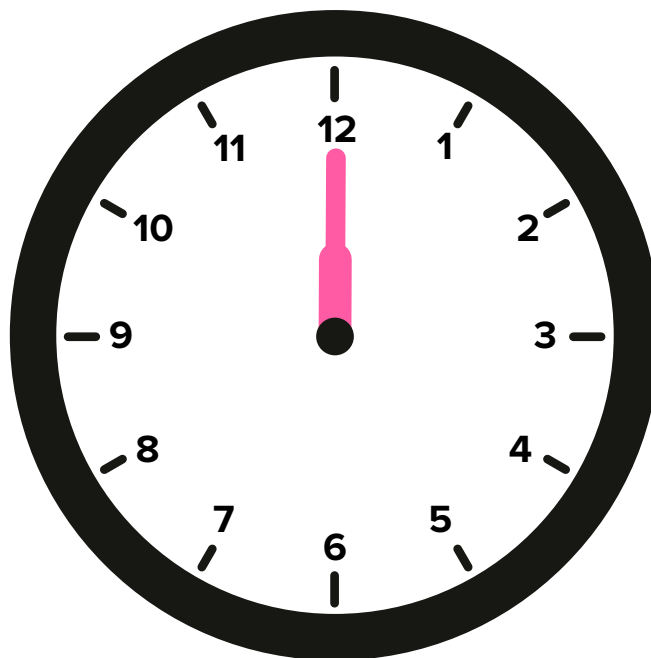

The Brilliant Bodies Zone is all about our bodies.

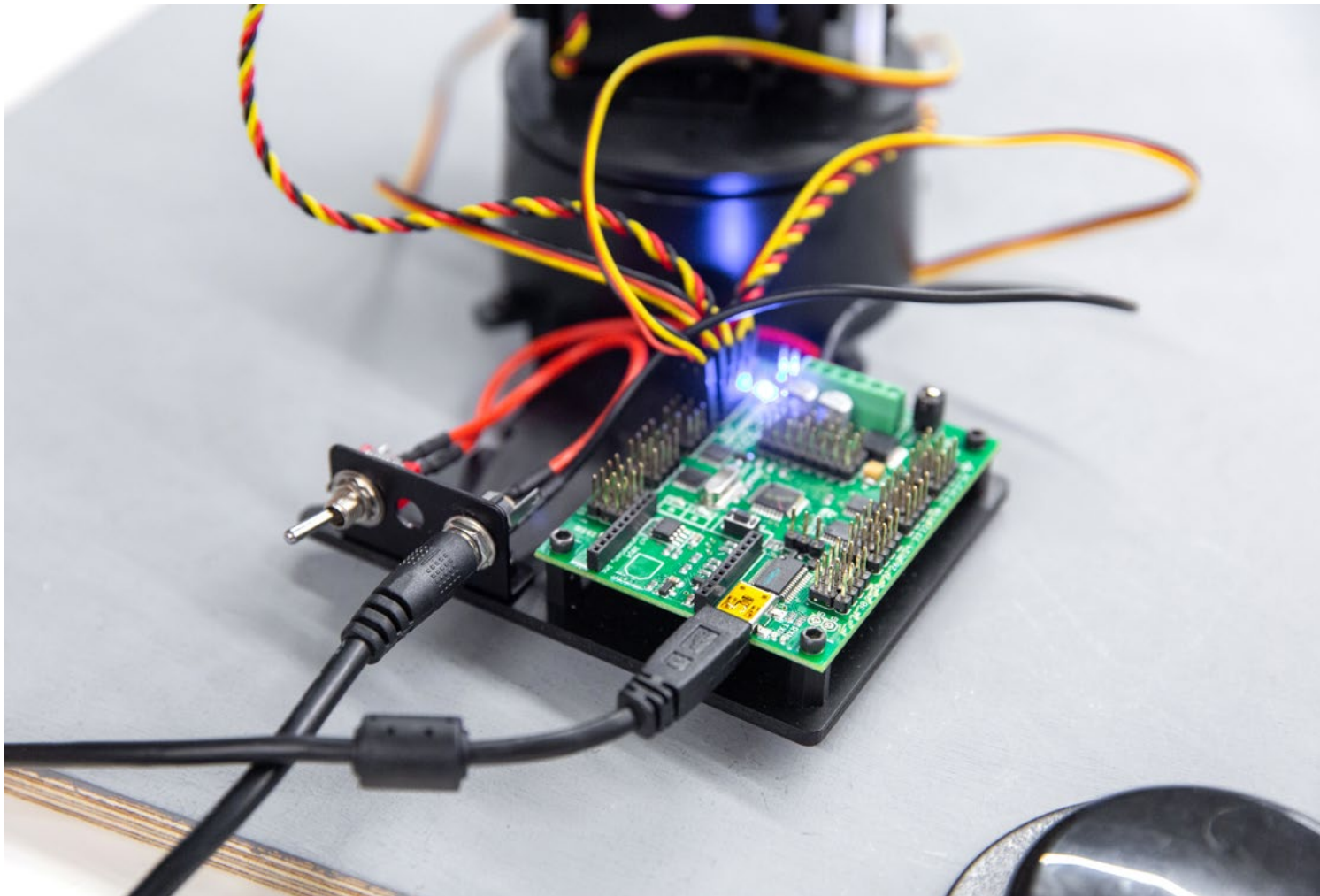

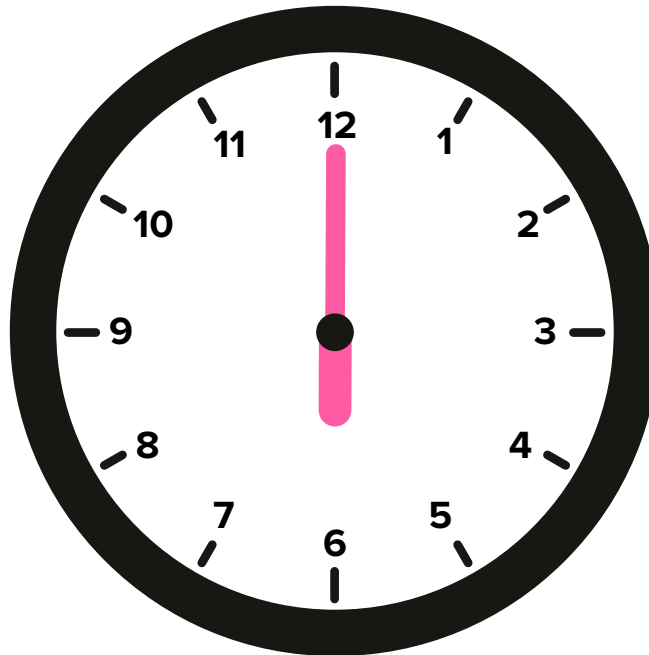
There are lots of staff to **help** you when you visit. They will be wearing a pink jacket.
